The presentation emphasizes that the integration of strategic and tactical supply management is not a one – time decision but a continual effort. Team work is not just about consensus building but complimenting each other to minimize disconnects that continue to exist within supply management, the corporation, and the supply base. To high light these issues, Dr. Morey draws on more than 42 years experience to identify what he sees as common strategic and tactical activities for the future, current disconnects which affect the company and supply base, and the importance of providing a uniform strategic and tactical image to suppliers.

About the Speaker:

DR. RUSSELL MOREY, C.P.M.

Dr. Russell Morey is Professor Emeritus of Supply Chain Management at Western Illinois University. He received his Ph.D. from the University of Nebraska in 1973, his C.P.M. in 1976, and started his career in higher education at Northwest Missouri State University in 1966. He developed and implemented the Operations/Purchasing program at Western in 1974 and facilitated the development of a Supply Chain Management Program in 1997. Dr. Morey is currently the President of Morey and Associates, an industrial training organization, and has conducted and teleconferenced numerous training programs for more than 35 Fortune 500 Corporations in Brazil, Canada, China, England, Germany, Mexico, and the United States. He has published numerous articles and cases, and has given presentations at various regional, national, and international conferences throughout the United States. He was also a contributing author of an Introduction To Management textbook. Dr. Morey has been listed in numerous Who's Who publications, the most recent being Who's Who Among America's Educators - 2002, and has received over 100 awards and certificates of achievement for his contributions to education and the purchasing profession. He was selected as the Outstanding Teacher in the College of Business and has received the Presidential Merit Award from Western Illinois University. He also received the Professional Advancement Award from Western Illinois University and the Outstanding Service Award in the College of Business and Technology in 1999.
